There are still many other equipment needs that would allow for more diagnostics to be done by our medical staff such as:

- A real exam table with stirrups for full exam: what we have budgeted for are simple "massage" tables
- Disposable speculums
- A new chart system for our increasing number of returning patients
- Microscope and slides for vaginal and urine exams
- Centrifuge and all for urine spin downs

With that said: here is a beginning Wish List for Our Patients at Our Lady of Angel's Saint Joseph Clinic-

- * Approval of our plans for expansion from the Architectural Review Board
- * Securing a bid in our price range with a local contractor
- * Enlist students from George Stone as apprentices in all construction aspects
- * Engage patients in the lifting, loading, painting, landscaping and other aspects of the construction
- * Purchase building materials through Habitat
- * Record the events leading up to the opening Day of our expansion

- * Purchase 2 more computers to have one per exam room @ \$900.00 each= \$1800.00
- * Obtain Rosetta Stone for Spanish: will look for a used one on Amazon.com
- * Look for Chairs for the exam and waiting rooms: 10 sturdy chairs @ \$60.00/each= \$600.00 (donated chairs would be great)
- * Purchase goose neck lamps x 2 @ \$200.00 each= \$400.00
- * Have a functioning nebulizer: dedicated for clinic use as well as extras and accessories: would look for donations
- * Obtain glucometers with strips and lancets: would solicit from pharmaceutical companies
- * Erect Wall mounts for patient education material in exam rooms and waiting rooms: would use any from renovations of area offices
- * Provide Wall mounts to organize forms: donations and creativity would work
- * Expand volunteers proficiency thru Electronic Medical Record training using Carescope: will use current Carescope to expand our participation in EMR, but will need dedicated trainers
- * Request funding for Paper and postage: that is always a need: @ \$500.00

- * Seek a publishing account for business cards, brochure for marketing and fund raising: would ask for discounts, ideas and such from local advertising and publishing companies
- * Engage in improving current "limited" resources such as We Care: work with We Care and explore community resources to optimize referral network for patients
- * Develop Fund Raisers for diagnostic procedures: labs, X-Rays, MRI's, Ultra sounds in a timely fashion: MacMillan Fund is limited
- * Apply for other grants to support costlier, but more effective meds after failed trials of generic medications
- * Become more visible with Community awareness articles
- * Interview and collect stories, photos for publication and sale to raise money This would be a history of the clinic with stories from those with a vision, patients, volunteers and all who have been touched by the "family of care" at St. Joseph's Clinic.
